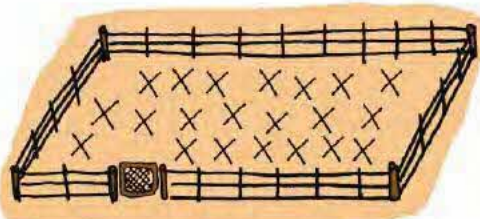

TAKE A SOIL SAMPLE TO DETERMINE LIME AND FERTILIZER REQUIREMENTS (EVERY THIRD YEAR)

MINIMUM OF 20 CORES

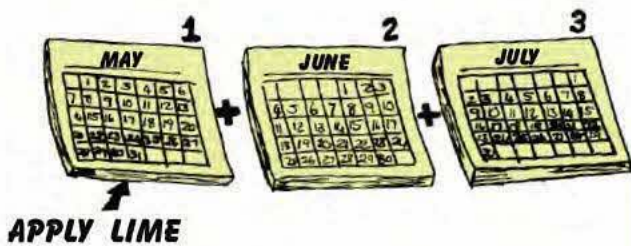


MIX WELL

PUT SAMPLE IN BOX AND SEND TO CEDARA



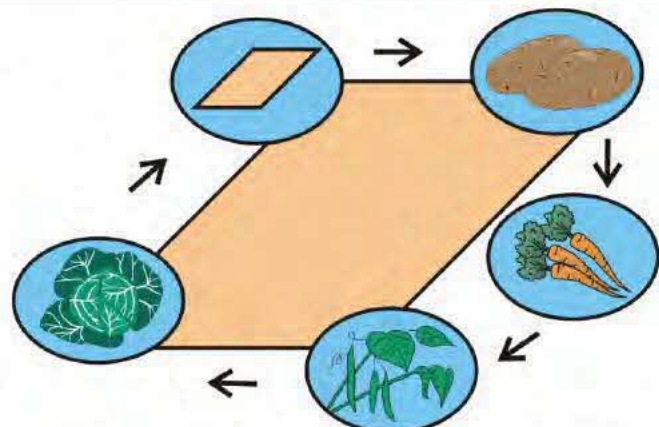
IF RECOMMENDED APPLY LIME ACCORDING TO SOIL ANALYSIS, 1 - 3 MONTHS BEFORE PLANTING



PLOUGH OR DEEP WORK SOIL WITH A FORK OR SPADE



NEVER PLANT POTATOES EVERY YEAR IN THE SAME PLACE; PRACTICE CROP ROTATION



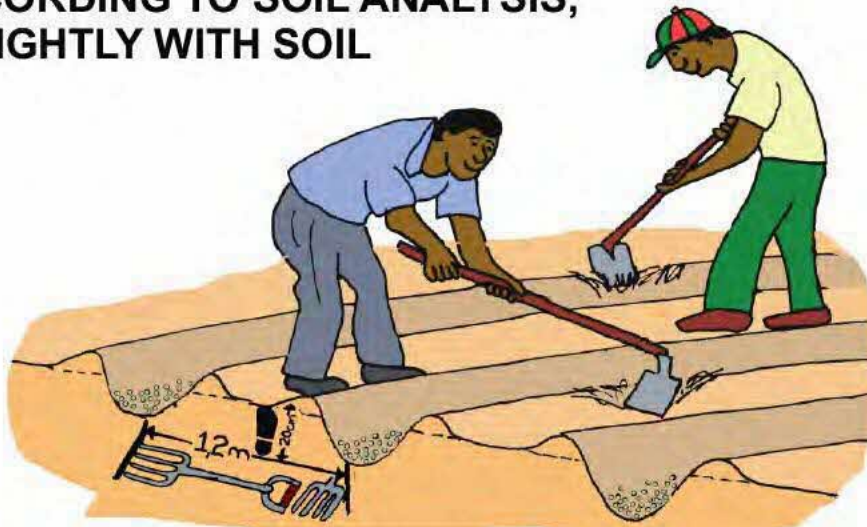

AFTER LIME HAS BEEN APPLIED**

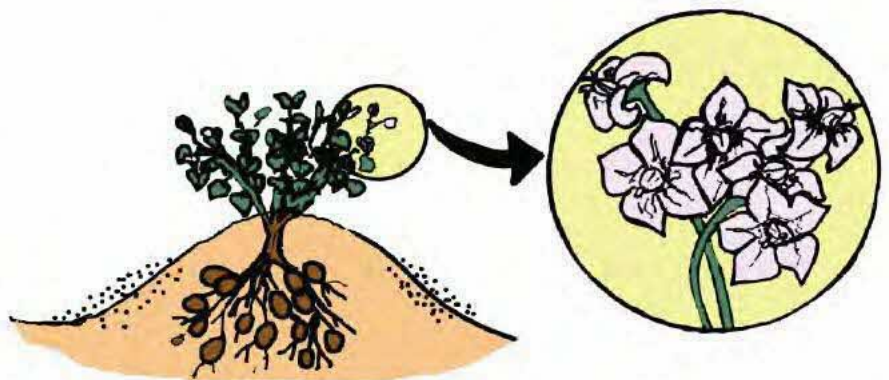

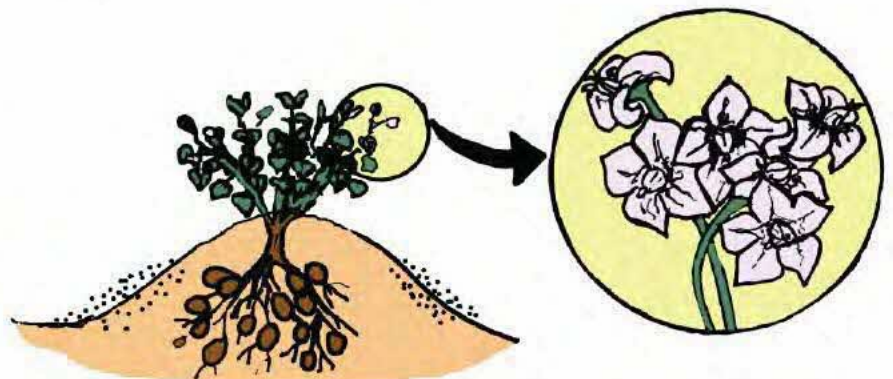

PLANT WELL SPROUTED TUBERS IN FURROWS 20-30cm APART



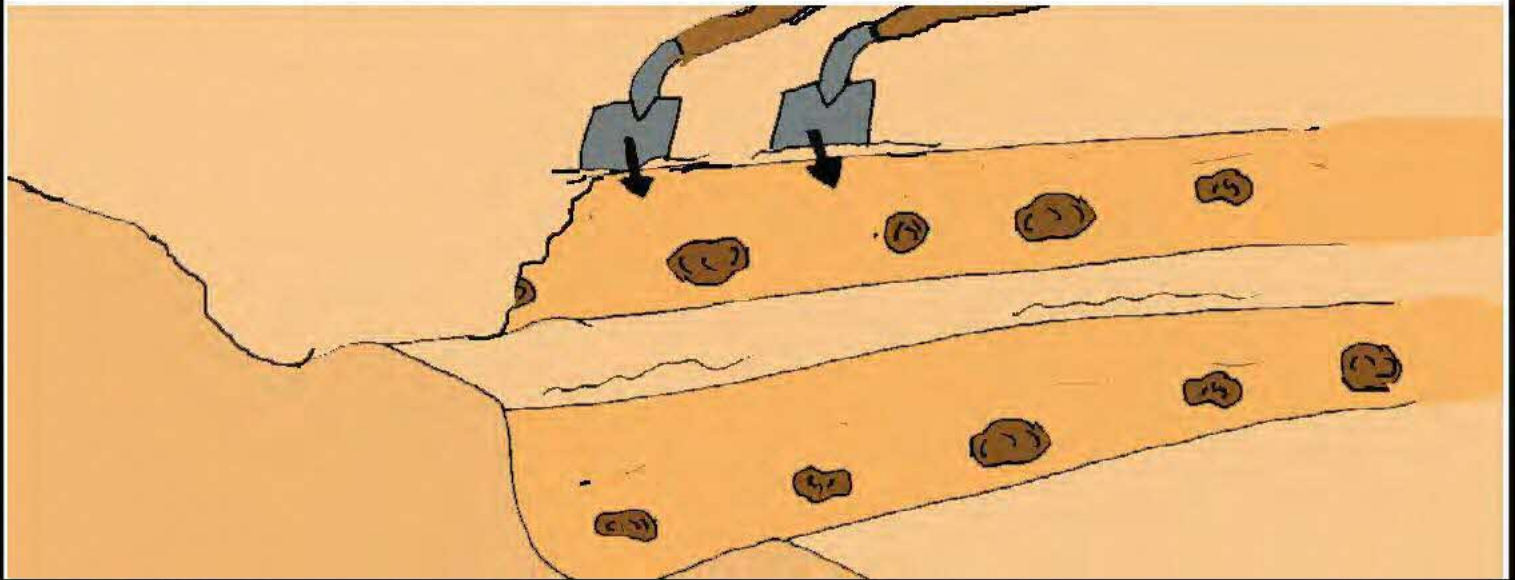

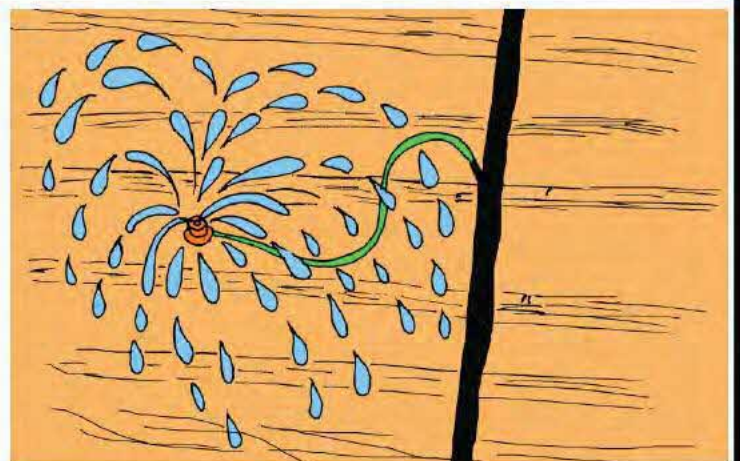

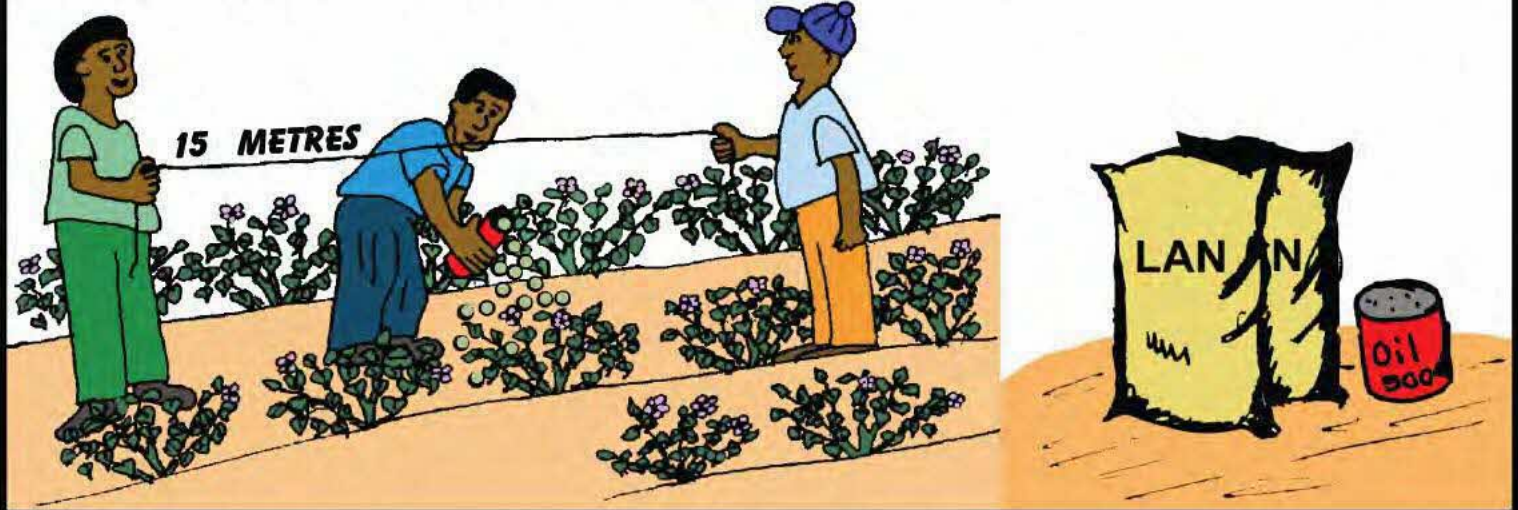

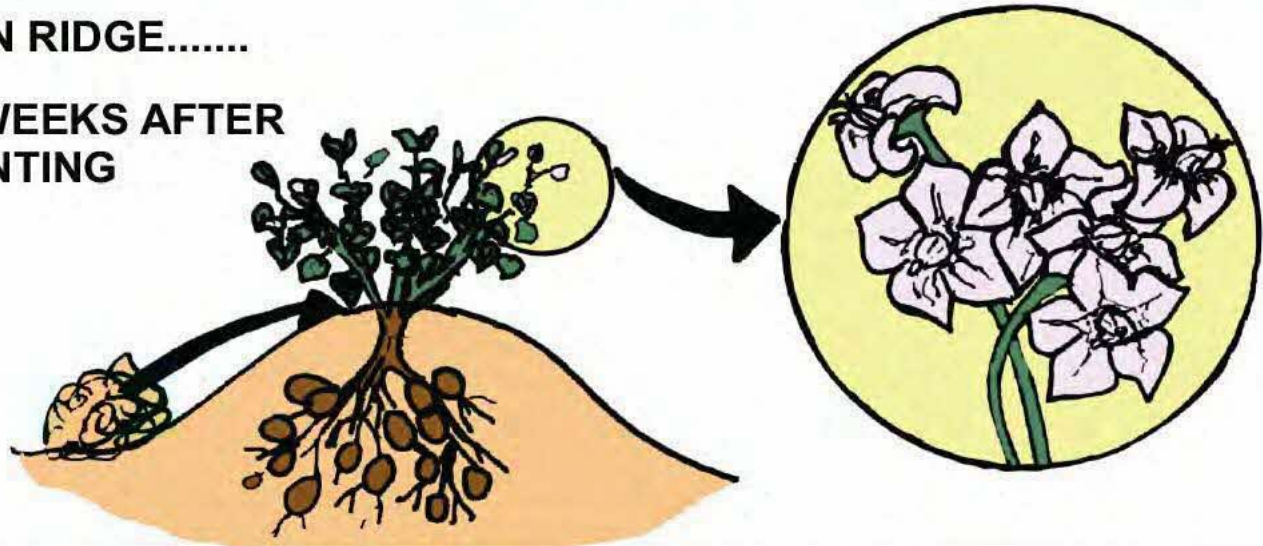

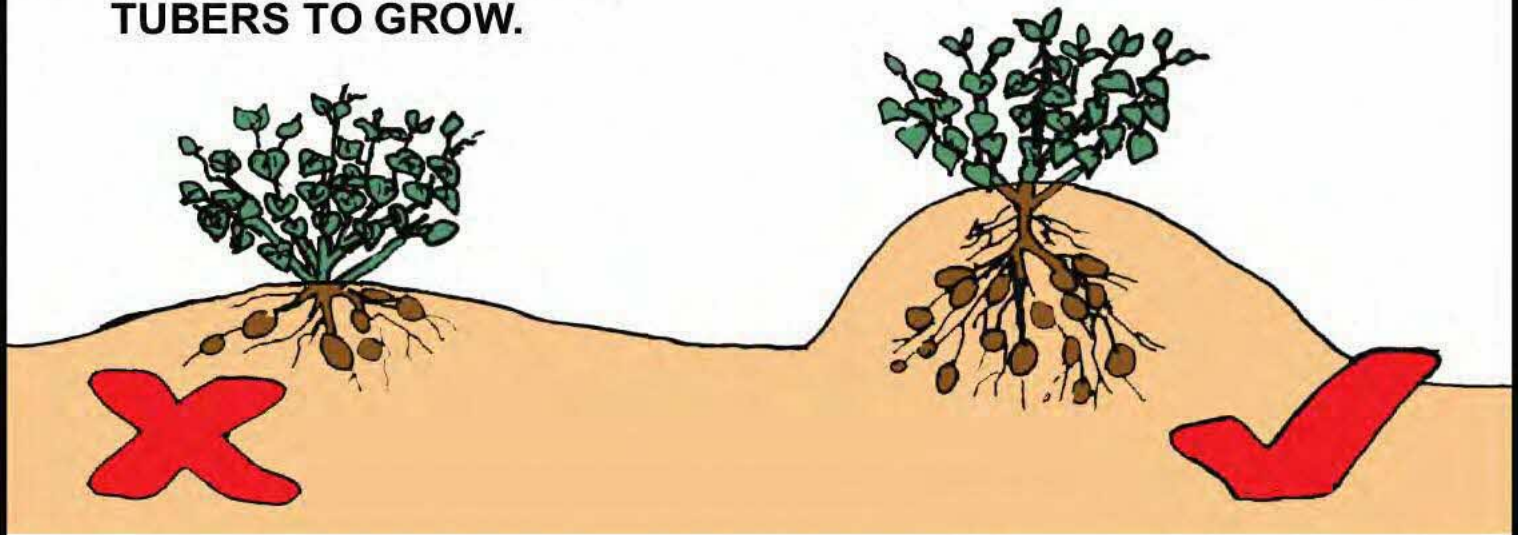

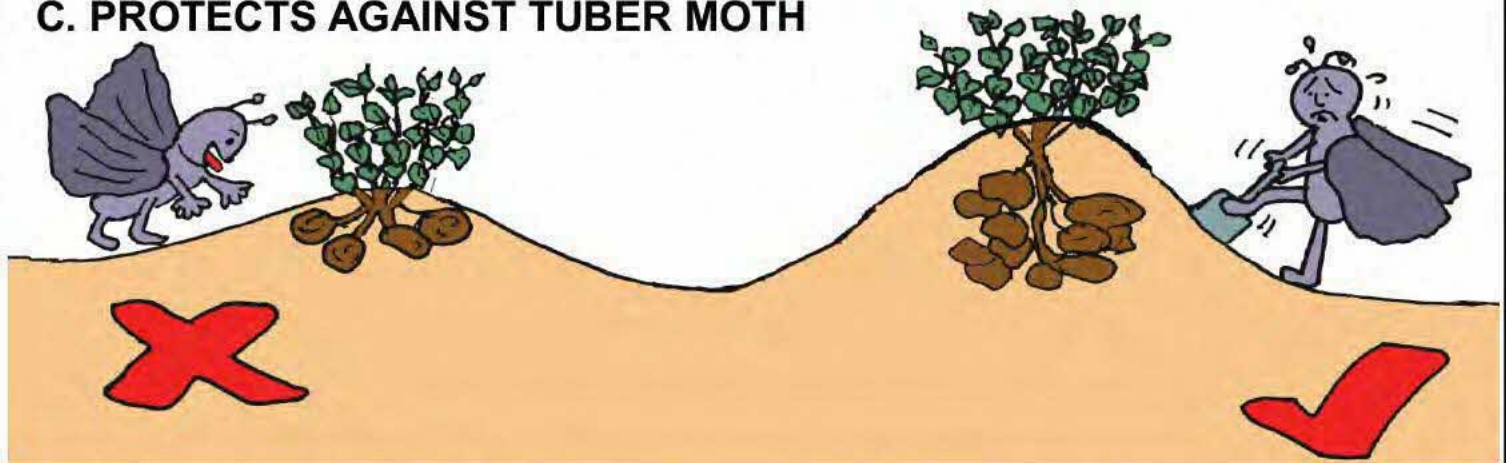

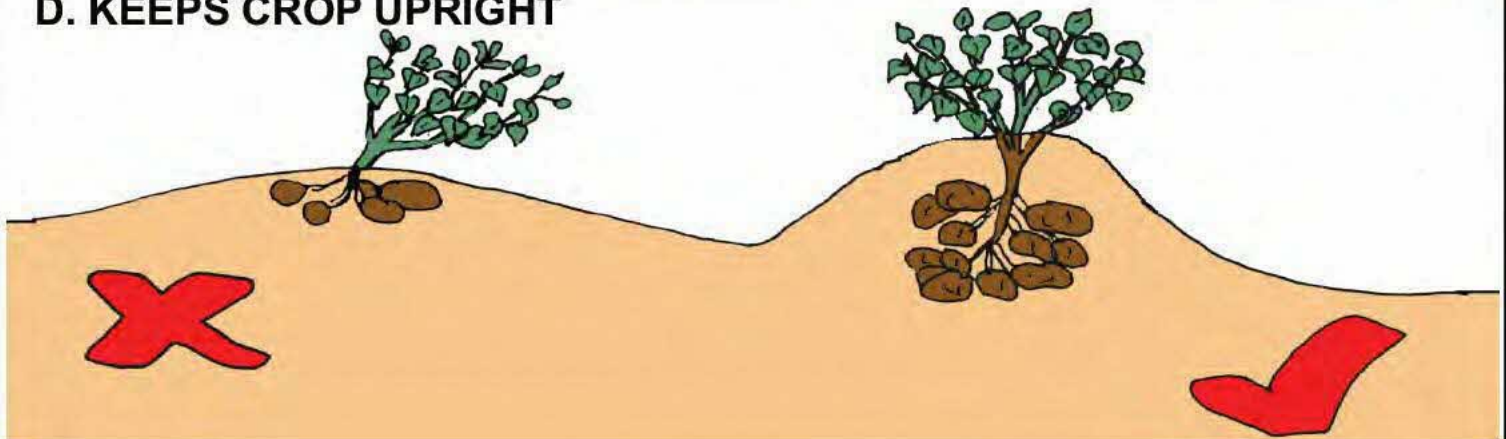

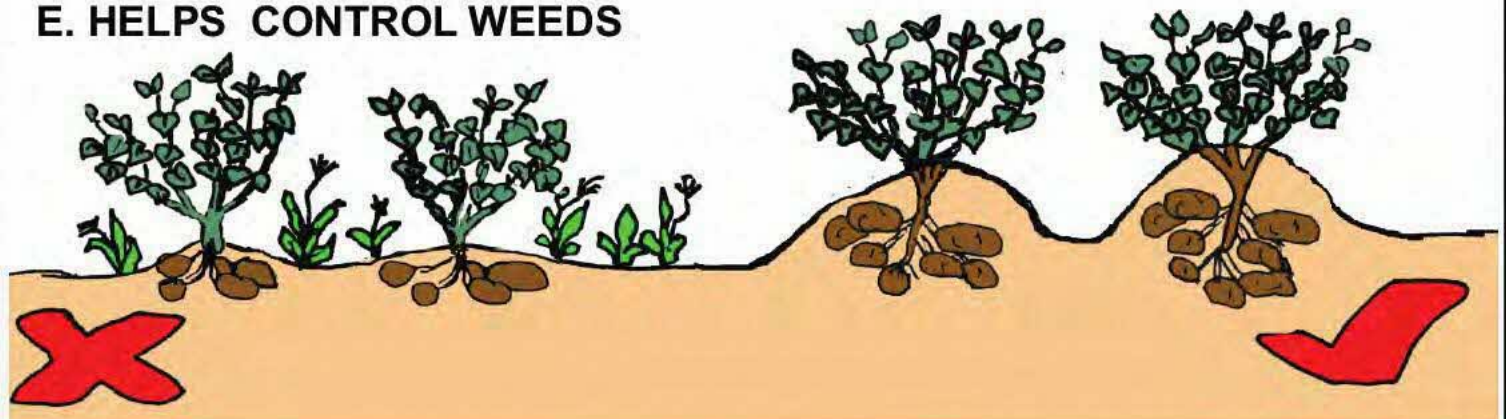

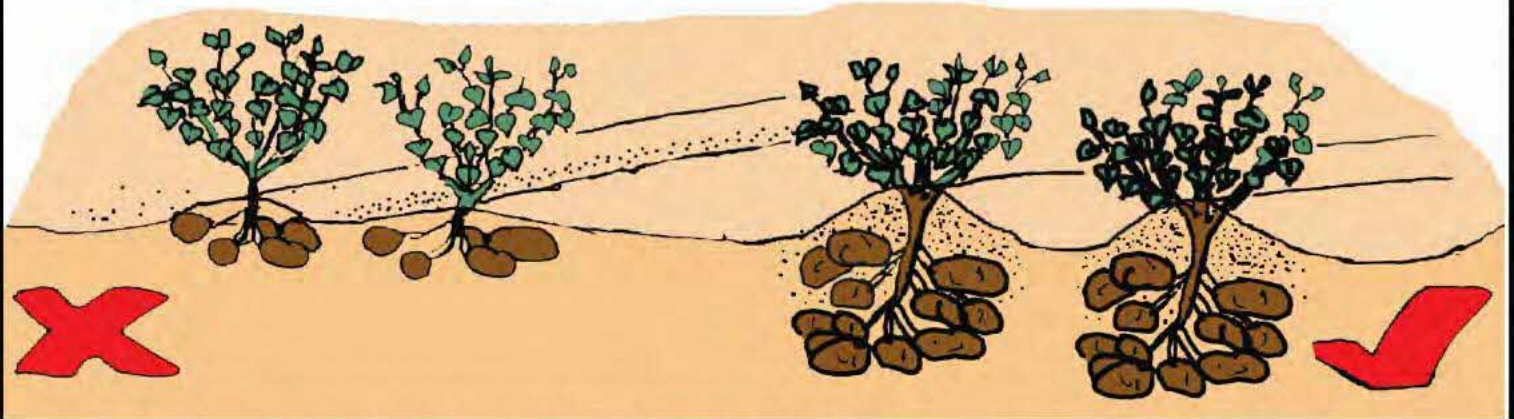

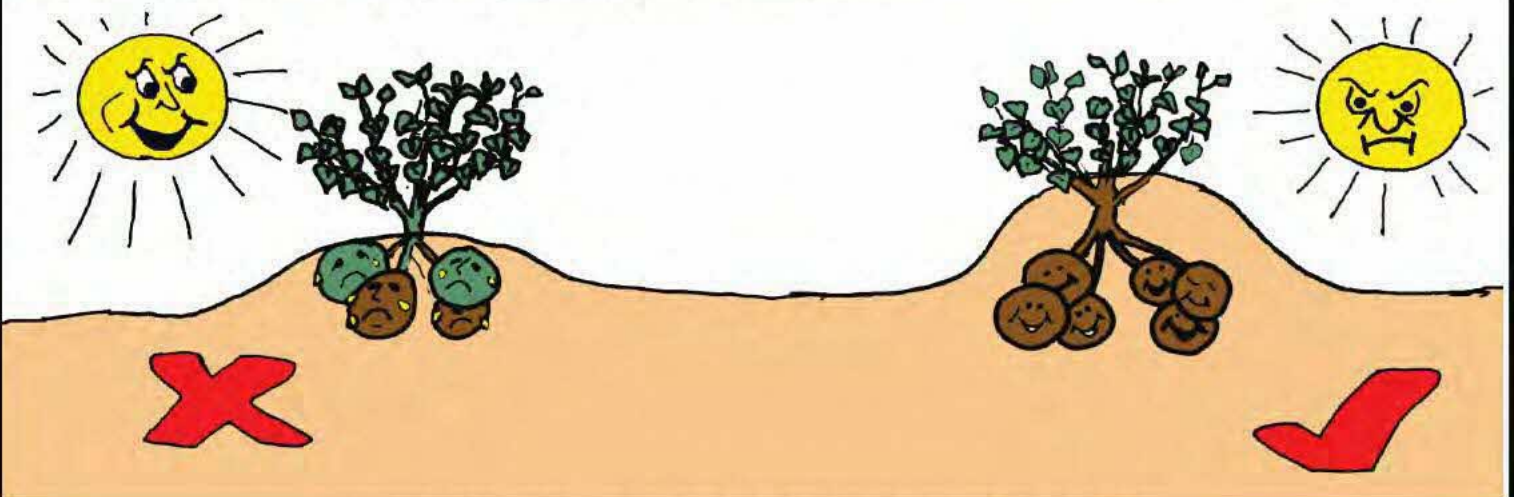

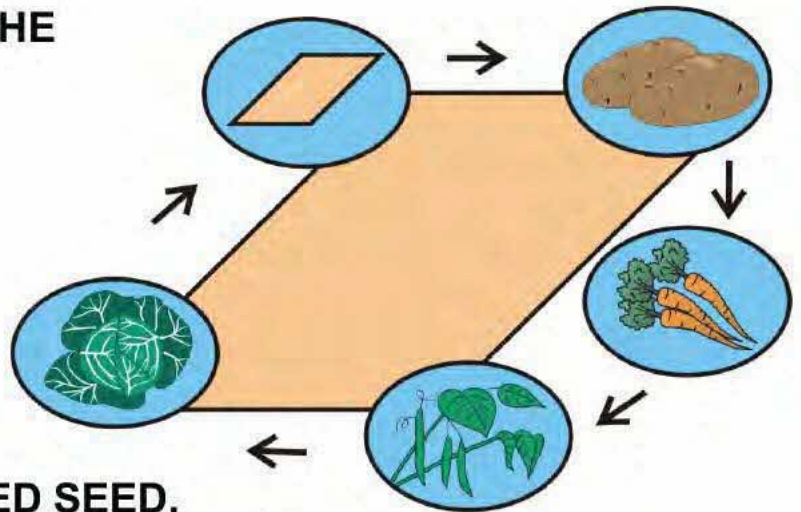
WEED CONTROL

- AFTER RIDGING

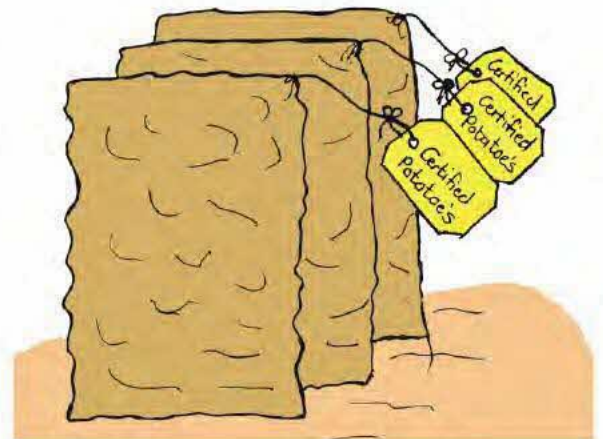


DO NOT PLANT POTATOES IN THE SAME PLACE EVERY YEAR: PRACTICE CROP ROTATION

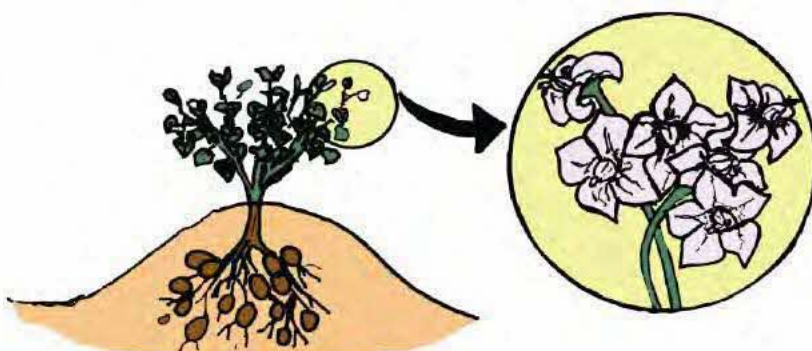


PLANT GOVERNMENT CERTIFIED SEED, CULTIVARS SUCH AS MNANDI AND ASTRID

NEVER PLANT YOUR OWN HOME GROWN SEED



IF NECESSARY, SPRAY POTATOES (MAINLY BP 1) WITH DITHANE M45 EVERY 7 DAYS AFTER START OF FLOWERING



DISEASE IDENTIFICATION



EARLY BLIGHT

CIRCULAR OR ANGULAR LESIONS WITH A YELLOW BORDER, OCCUR AFTER WARM MOIST CONDITIONS.



LATE BLIGHT

WATER-SOAKED DARK AREAS ON LEAVES, OCCUR AFTER MOIST WEATHER



VIRUS INFECTION

DWARFED PLANTS WITH YELLOW OR LEATHERY LEAVES



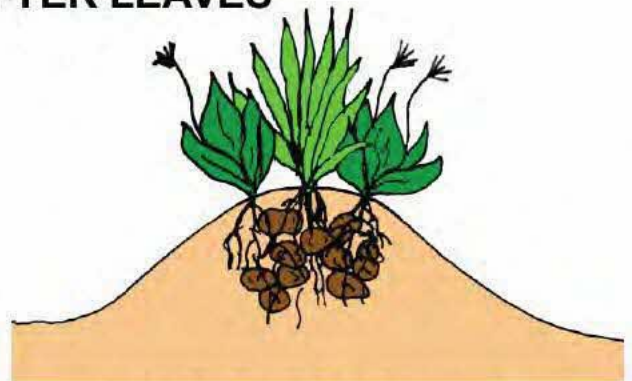
TO HARVEST - USE A FORK OR SINGLE FURROW PLOUGH TO LIFT POTATOES
- DO NOT LEAVE POTATOES LYING IN THE SUN



START TO HARVEST 2-3 WEEKS AFTER LEAVES AND STEMS HAVE DIED

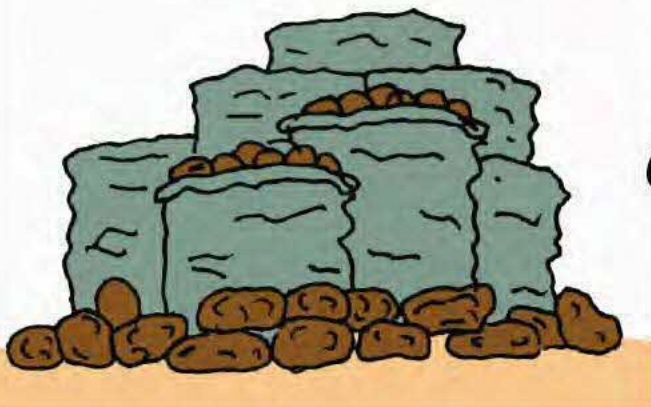


WAIT FOR 2 WEEKS



HARVEST BEFORE WEEDS DAMAGE AND COVER POTATOES

KEEP HARVESTED POTATOES IN A DRY, COOL AND DARK PLACE
